Hagalleria is a contemporary art gallery marked by the dialogue and exchange aroused by the artists. Muriel and Daniel want Hagalleria, "the gallery" in Hebrew, to be both an intimate and open place.

Its first exhibition, from March the 20th to June the 7th, will be dedicated to the Israeli photographer Yigal Féliks. It is a personal exhibition composed of nineteen pictures taken from four different series.

Hagalleria will be present at the "Salon du Livre" (Paris International Book Fair) from March the 14th to March the 19th and will exhibit the artists of the gallery as well as two books by the photographer Didier Benloulou, "Jaffa, la passe" and "Sincérité du visage". The pictures of the artists will also be shown at the VIP space of the fair.

Following the example of writers and movie directors of Hebraic language, henceforth known and valued by the French public, Israeli plastician artists and photographers are still looking for their identity. Sixty years after the creation of their State, in a complex geopolitical context, they are leading this quest both on an individual and collective level.

Seven exhibitions are under way for the season 2008/2009. They will be dedicated to confirmed artists in Israel, whose works have been acquired by or shown in foreign museums and galleries. Didier Ben Loulou, who is working on a new book devoted to Jerusalem, will be the subject of an exhibition during fall 2008. Wiser for their experiences and passions, the gallery owners will unveil the works of new talents.

Muriel and Daniel have lived two years in Tel-Aviv, the White City, known for its numerous galleries and museums.
